

Immigration (Visa) (Exemption)
(Events Company of St. Lucia Inc.) Order

SAINT LUCIA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2020, No. 4

[13th January, 2020]

In exercise of the power conferred under section 7 of the Immigration Act, Cap. 10.01, the Minister responsible for Home Affairs makes this Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Visa) (Exemption) (Events Company of St. Lucia Inc.) Order, 2020.

Exemption

2.—(1) Subject to subsection (2), a visiting artist, fashion designer, model, dancer, chef and production crew employed with the Saint Lucia Jazz Festival, Mercury Fest, Roots & Soul Festival, Saint Lucia Carnival, Food & Rum Festival, Arts & Heritage Festival and the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers are exempted from section 7 of the Immigration Act, Cap. 10.01 with respect to the requirement to obtain a visa for entry into Saint Lucia.

(2) The exemption granted under subsection (1) is —

- (a) applicable for a period of two years commencing from the 18th day of April, 2019 and terminating on the 17th day of April, 2021;
- (b) subject to the condition that Events Company of St. Lucia Inc. complies with the monitoring requirements of the Ministry of Tourism, Information and Broadcasting, Culture and Creative Industries.
